**BRING SAFETY/SECURITY TO THE POLITICAL FOREFRONT**

- Emphasize security in the municipal plan.
- Specify the visions in an architecture policy

**IMPLEMENT VISIONS INTO REALITY**

- Work strategically and physically with security
- Use the overall plan as a guiding thread for security
- Incorporate security into the local plans
- Utilize area renewals to uplift worn-down areas
